Last month, the STWA Board took action to set the date, time and place for the necessary public hearing on this annexation. The public hearing will occur immediately prior to the Board meeting. Staff does not anticipate any public attendance on the matter unless the landowner decides to attend.

Analysis:

This annexation is part of the long-term project lead by Nueces County and their Grant Administration office. The project included grant funds from the Texas Department of Agriculture and Texas Water Development Board for a planning study, distribution lines in the Cyndie Park Subdivision, a transmission line extending from NWSC's closest 6" line and the soon to be constructed new pump station immediately north of the existing Banquete Pump Station.

Annexing the property into STWA's district results in the NWSC retail customer paying the same inside district rates for service as other NWSC customers. Without the annexation, an outside district customer would pay NWSC monthly minimums and cost per 1000g but would not pay the STWA taxes paid by other NWSC retail customers. With the adoption of the enclosed Resolution 19-21, STWA staff will contact the Nueces County Appraisal District and the property will be added to STWA's rolls.





On Monday, April 8th, the Nueces Water Supply Corporation (NWSC) began serving water to the area. However, as reported previously, property owners living outside STWA's district that request retail water service from the NWSC will request annexation into STWA's district in order to pay the same cost for service as other NWSC retail customers. Last month, the STWA Board took action to set the date, time and place for the necessary public hearing on this annexation. The public hearing will occur immediately prior to the Board meeting. Staff does not anticipate any public attendance on the matter unless the landowner decides to attend.

Analysis:

This annexation is part of the long-term project lead by Nueces County and their Grant Administration office. The project included grant funds from the Texas Department of Agriculture and Texas Water Development Board for a planning study, distribution lines in the Cyndie Park Subdivision, a transmission line extending from NWSC's closest 6" line and the soon to be constructed new pump station immediately north of the existing Banquete Pump Station.

Annexing the property into STWA's district results in the NWSC retail customer paying the same inside district rates for service as other NWSC customers. Without the annexation, an outside district customer would pay NWSC monthly minimums and cost per 1000g but would not pay the STWA taxes paid by other NWSC retail customers. With the adoption of the enclosed Resolution 19-24, STWA staff will contact the Nueces County Appraisal District and the property will be added to STWA's rolls.







- Re: South Texas Water Authority Cross Training and Standard Operating Procedures

Background:

In previous Weekly Updates, staff reported that field and office personnel have been working on standard operating procedures (SOPs) and essential operational information. As the Board is aware, with the exception of the two cathodic protection technicians, all STWA employees perform STWA, Nueces Water Supply Corporation (NWSC), and Ricardo Water Supply Corporation (RWSC) tasks. The Board will also recall that the percentage of each employee's time is used to calculate the fees charged to the Corporations to recoup salaries, employee benefits and overhead. Although many of these tasks are already performed by more than one employee, some tasks are of a nature such that one specific person is responsible for a particular duty. Many of these duties/tasks already have instructions to assist staff in the absence of the person that typically performs the job. However, as previously reported, staff is working on creating binders with SOPs and Information Sheets as a means of ensuring efficient operations.

Analysis:

Enclosed are the Table of Contents for STWA, NWSC and RWSC SOPs and Information Sheets. The Table of Contents are divided into the following binders: Finance, Business Office and Technological Procedures, Personnel, SCADA, Pump Station, Operations and Monitoring. The majority of the SOPs and Information Sheets are complete. However, as these documents have been drafted, additional subjects have surfaced and staff recognizes that the binders will be modified as operation procedures change.

Staff Recommendation:

Continue to work on the completion of the existing Table of Contents and amend as needed.

Board Action:

Provide feedback to staff.

Summarization:

Due to the size of staff, there has always been a need for one or more individuals to know how to perform another employee's tasks. In addition, I believe it warrants stating that STWA has been fortunate to have employees that are willing to help and assist whenever a co-worker is unavailable.
